After studying relative positions of Headstone Elizabeth Quinn and Footstone E.Q., two possibilities exist: (1) The Headstone Elizabeth Quinn was found badly out of position, or (2) There are two Elizabeth Quinns buried near each other, mother and daughter.

SAINT PAUL'S OF ELLICOTT CITY CEMETERY MONUMENT INSCRIPTIONS

The following is from "Howard County Maryland Records, Volume II: More Cemeteries" compiled by the Howard county Genealogical Society.

Description: This cemetery was used during the 1800's and early 1900's. It lies on the south side of Rt. 144 about 500 yards west of the intersection of Rt. 99 and 144 on the western side of Ellicott City. It is bounded by the Tiber River in the front or north side, a ravine on the West Side, a barbed wire fence on the south side, and private property on the East Side. The present day topography of the land is of a relatively level wooded main area separated from a steep wooded hillside area by another ravine.

Work was done on this cemetery as an Eagle Scout project. The Scouts who worked on this project attempted to restore all fallen stones to original locations unless erosion or tree growth made it impossible. In these instances, they were located as accurately as possible. Since two stones were discovered completely buried, it is possible there are still others undiscovered.

The following readings were taken as part of this project. Each stone was read independently by two persons, and any discrepancies checked by a third person. Badly worn stones where error was possible have been marked as such.

This work and recording (entailing about 300 work hours) was done by the Scouts of Troop 305 of St. John's Episcopal, Church (Scoutmaster Robert Scarburgh) under the leadership of Jeff Kempic whose Eagle project it was. Scouts participating were: Mike Flynn, Tom Flynn, Jon Grove, Andy Hill, Gary Kempic, Gregg Kempic, Jeff Kempic, Jim Lebling, Tim Lebling, Richard Moore, Tom Rudzinski, Mike Spittler, Steve Spittler, Simon Swain and Ernie Tait.
